



Both Neubreisach groups, Geiswasser (top) and Obersaasheim, were designed in 1899 and constructed in following years. Their composition is corresponding, and consisted of regular shelters of the 1887 design series: A-Räume (two in Obersaasheim, one in Geiswasser). M-Räume (2 and 1) and I-Räume (2 and 1). Besides, their armament is quite similar, too. Both provided over a turret battery with four 6-cm P.T. disappearing guns, and, moreover, shielded 10-cm gun S.L. batteries (Geiswasser 1 x 4 and Obersaasheim 2 x 3). Around the perimetre and on the ramparts small observation positions were installed, predecessors of the later 'snails'.
